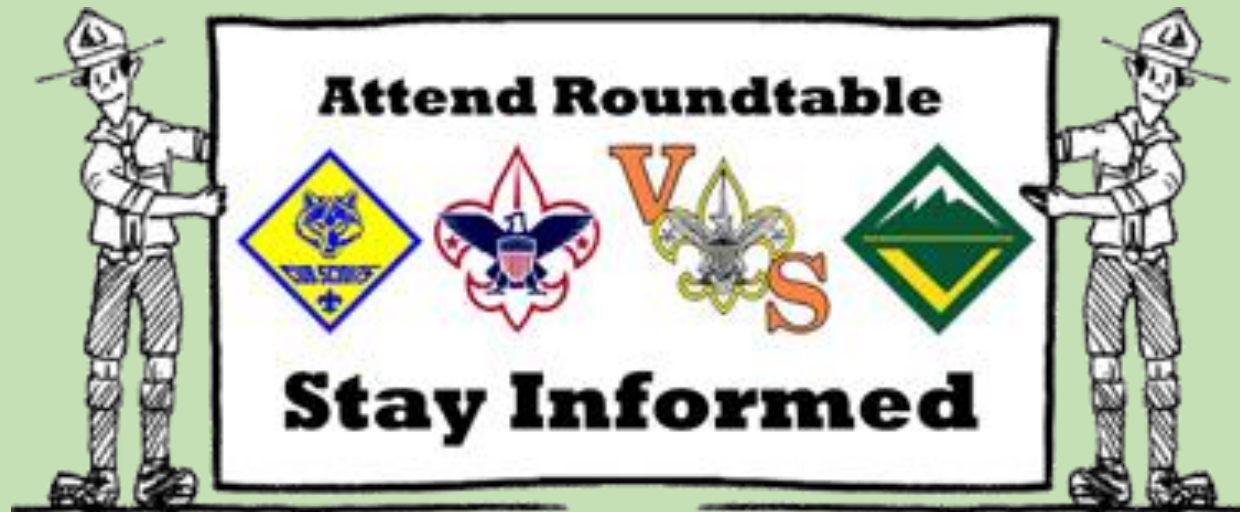

- Internet Advancement - An issue that caused some leaders not to see their position under the fleur-de-lis drop down in the upper right corner of the Internet Advancement window has been fixed. If you still do not see your position listed, hold down the shift key while clicking your browser refresh button to force a reload of the page.

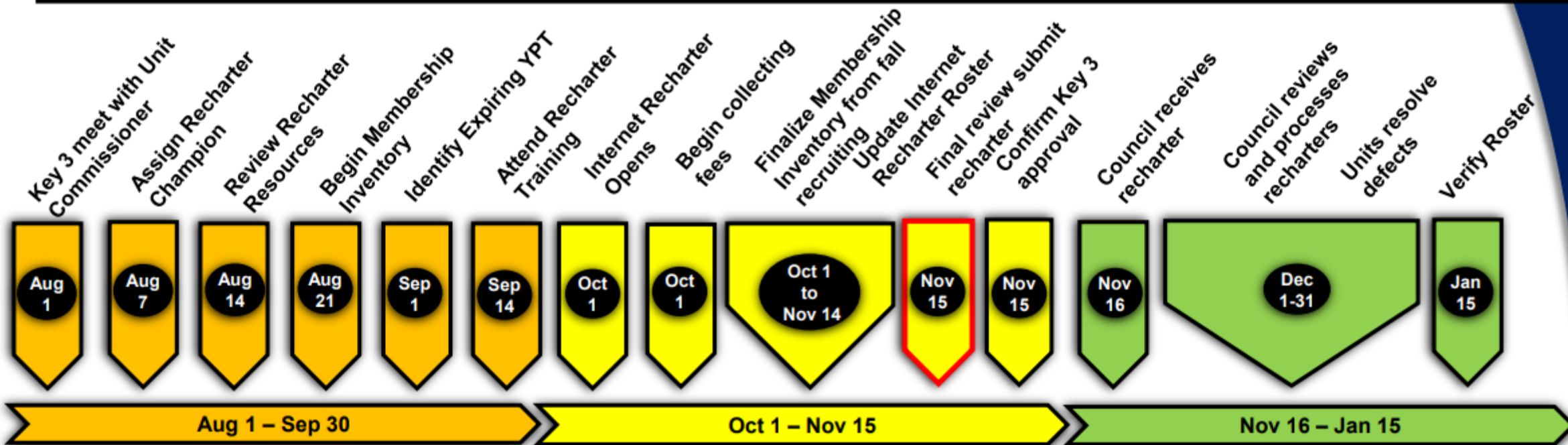
- Calendar - An issue that caused leaders to be omitted from the invitee list for campout events has been fixed.
- Date Joined Field - The Date Joined fields have been restored to the Edit Extended Information page.
- Hello World NOVA Award - An issue that prevented the Hello World NOVA Award patch from being displayed on the Scout's page has been fixed.
- Leader Invitations
 - The leader invitation e-mail will now include the ID and Password if the adult has never logged into my.scoutbook.com 3
 - The leader invitation e-mail will only include the ID if the adult has previously logged into my.scouting.org 2
 - The send invite again button will not be displayed if the adult does not have an e-mail address in Scoutbook.
- Youth Page - An issue that prevented the youth position patch from displaying in some cases has been fixed.

New Features

- Rank/Merit Badge/Adventure Page - The version date will now be displayed at the top of all Rank, Merit Badge and Adventure pages in Scoutbook.
- Merit Badges - The version of a Merit Badge can be changed after the Merit Badge is started. If the Merit Badge version is changed, completed requirements are **not** migrated from the former version to the new version.

December Recharter Unit Timeline



Aug 1 – Sep 30

Oct 1 – Nov 15

Nov 16 – Jan 15

Stage 1 - Recharter Prep

1. Meet with unit commissioner review recharter timeline
2. Assign recharter champion
3. Review recharter resources
4. Begin membership inventory
5. Identify YPT expiring before Mar 1

Stage 2 - Internet Recharter

1. Update/Add/Remove members from roster
2. Re-check and verify YPT training
3. Finalize membership inventory/fall recruitment
4. Collect fees & submit roster
5. Member of key 3 approves

Stage 3 - Council Process

1. Council receives recharter
2. Validates recharter
3. Unit resolve defects or missing paperwork
4. Unit verifies My.Scouting roster

Internet Advancement 2.0 (my.scouting.org)

- Only Unit Key 3 and Key 3 Delegates can input to recharter
- Log in with my.scouting.org & Scoutbook username & password
- Click “Update Unit Roster” to pull in new data/members every time you log in to the recharter portal
- Be sure to “Refresh Roster” periodically to add in Youth/Adults that have joined after the roster was generated

Rechartering in Internet Advancement 2.0

- Window opens 2 Oct (90 days ahead of expiration)
- Delete/Add/Invite members, ID multiples, change positions, upload docs
- Please have your Unit Commissioner, District Renewal Processor or District Commissioner to review your roster before “Submitting to Council”
- Once reviewed, “Submit to Council”
- Any Key 3 member can approve with Adobe digital signature
- Print copy of final approved roster, send to UC/DC

2023 National and Council Fees

- Youth Fee* \$75.00 per paid member
 - Adults (Lion/Tiger Adult Partners, EO – No Fee)* \$45.00 per paid member
 - Exploring Youth** \$45.00 per paid member
 - New Scout Fee \$25.00 per new Scout
 - Scout Life \$15.00 per subscription
 - Council Insurance \$ 2.04 per paid member
- (Tiger/Lion Partners do not pay)
- Unit Charter Renewal \$100.00 per unit

* - Multiples in traditional units only pay once (Packs, Troops, Crews & Ships).

** - Multiple registrations between Exploring and Traditional units do not exist. Members in both programs, pay both fees.

Payment

- Recommend Unit Check paid to Council
 - Credit card and E-check payment goes directly to National – Registrar cannot adjust charter until a refund is rec'd (4-6 weeks or longer)
 - Unit check to Council goes into Unit account – Registrar can fix charter without waiting for a refund.
 - DE can turn in Unit check to Council
- Submit to Council – Target is October 24

General Information

- An adult Tiger or Lion partner is not a registered position (but they are assigned a BSA ID)
- A previous or current Tiger or Lion partner registering in a committee or leader/assistant leader position must fill out an adult *paper application* with the CBC form & YPT certificate
 - Write in the Tiger or Lion Parent BSA ID on the new adult application, so all training is transferred to the new adult profile
- Annual Charter Agreement can be done separately
 - Recommend completion by EOM September to confirm commitment by sponsor to continue chartering your unit

How to have a successful submission!

Be on the lookout for:

- Missing Signed Criminal Background Check Approval Form
- Missing or Expired Youth Protection Training
- Missing Signatures (Applications, Background Checks)
- Missing information on the application (DOB, SSN or false SSN)
- Missing Key 3 Approval
- Missing Adult Applications
- Money Incorrect (in 2021 was software and process issue)
- Youth Turned 18 – Needs Youth Protection Training, Criminal Background Check, and Adult Application

Only the unit can fix these issues

FAQs – Internet Recharter 2.0

Q – Why am I receiving an error message regarding Council ACH payments on the Commissioner Recharter dashboard?

A – This issue is encountered when the councils has not yet set up their ACH. ACH enable the council to receive funds from National.

Q – Why can I not upload zip and other conventional files

A – Zip files are allowed when the “upload documents” button is clicked. Zip files are NOT allowed when adding a new paper application. An earlier issue with uploading zip files was due to a file size limitation. That has since been resolved.

Q – How do I change volunteers listed as multiples or revise payment details from one unit to another?

A –A key3 can select a multiple, click “manage members” then “unmark as multiple.”

Q – Why am I seeing a miscellaneous extra fee charged for each of our volunteers?

A – If a council adds an additional fee for their units/volunteers that is not divisible by 12, the system prorates all fees on a monthly basis and the result is a rounding adjustment that occurs in the yearly charge.

Q – How does a scout add Scout Life if they registered online, did not select the feature, and wants to now receive the publication?

A – Request the council registrar to update the records and manually pay the difference

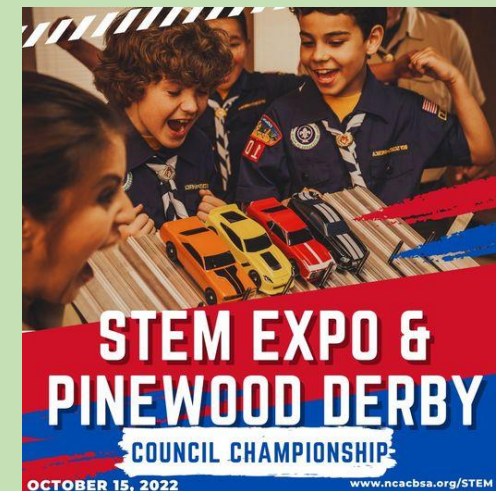

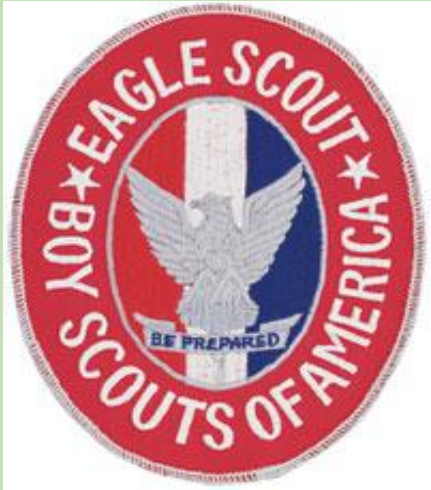

- The online Merit Badge Counselor [registration](#) works for all Scouters who do not already hold another District position.
- **New Merit Badge Counselors must complete online merit badge counselor training, in addition to YPT. Existing merit badge counselors have until 12/31/22 to complete training.**
- Be sure the counselor uses his/her legal name – no nicknames.
- Merit Badge Counselors, or the unit Dean/Leader, also need to scan and **send Margee the Merit Badge Counselor Information Form** listing the badges the counselor is applying to teach and providing a justification of his/her qualifications.
- Youth Protection Training is the essential first step. Don't hit "send" on the application without it!
